DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Dogs eligible to enter: This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are prohibited from the trial grounds.

ENTRY FEES

An entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class Entry fee \$20 first run and \$10 second, third, fourth run

Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

DAY OF TRIAL INFORMATION

Exhibitors MUST check-in before the start of the trial.

Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all runs safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes During runs, dogs may wear a properly fitted collar (no tags). Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times (except during judged runs), and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds. Dogs must enter and exit the agility area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the agility area before and after the run.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not elicible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the agility area when it is to be judged. The Club/Business has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Doors open at 7:45 Sunday morning.

Please do not allow your dog to potty in the building or on the artificial turf on the agility field.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

ACT1 and ACT1J Title

Section 13. ACT1/ACT1J. ACT1/ACT1J are entry level tests that are open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC Agility class and that meet the age and physical requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3). Dogs must have two passing ACT1 scores to earn the ACT1 title. For ACT1J dogs must have two passing ACT1J scores to earn the ACT1J title. To receive the title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the AKC. STANDARD Classes ACT1 (Standard) Performance Standards: • Minimum allowable score required to qualify = 85 • Performance will be judges as set forth in Chapter 5, Sections 4, 5 & 6 with the following exceptions: - Run-outs and Refusals will not be judged - More than 3 attempts at the next correct obstacle (ascent side of contacts) will result in a Mandatory Elimination and will be signaled with an "F" by the judge. - The 4 -Paw rule is not in effect ACT1 Standard Course Time: The time for all jump heights is 60 seconds. This is also maximum course time. The course must be completed in less than 60 seconds. ACT1 Minimum Obstacles Requirements: • Quantity =10-12 • Obstacles required, allowed and not allowed - refer to Section 15 for chart. • All obstacles must meet AKC equipment regulations in Chapter 3 JUMPERS Classes ACT1J (Jumpers) Performance Standards: • Minimum allowable score required to qualify = 85 • Performance will be judges as set forth in Chapter 5. Sections 4, 5 & 6 with the following exceptions: - Runouts and Refusals will not be judged - More than 3 attempts at the next correct obstacle will result in a Mandatory Elimination and will be signaled with an "F" by the judge. ACT1J Standard Course Time: The time for all jump heights is 50 seconds. This is also maximum course time. The course must be completed in less than 50 seconds. ACT1J Minimum Obstacles Requirements: • Quantity =10-12 • Obstacles required, allowed and not allowed - refer to Section 16 for chart. • All obstacles must meet AKC equipment regulations in Chapter 3
